This is an opportunity to lead a special organization that performs truly meaningful work.

The Executive Director is responsible for managing all aspects of our organization. The position works under the direction of our Board of Directors.

- Must successfully complete a comprehensive fingerprint criminal background investigation and a child welfare background investigation.
- Demonstrated ability to maintain impeccable professional boundaries and confidentiality.

- Includes occasional travel outside of the local area for meetings and training.
- This position results in exposure to traumatic content.
- This position may require occasional work hours in excess or outside of the normal workweek.
